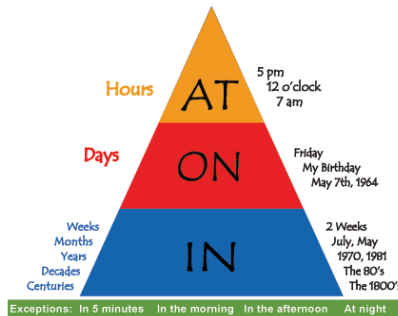

Do you play **any** sports?

- ❖ Yes, I play **some** sports.
- ❖ No, I don't play **any** sports.

Are there **any** students in the classroom?

- ❖ Yes, there are **some** students in the classroom
- ❖ No, there aren't **any** students in the classroom.

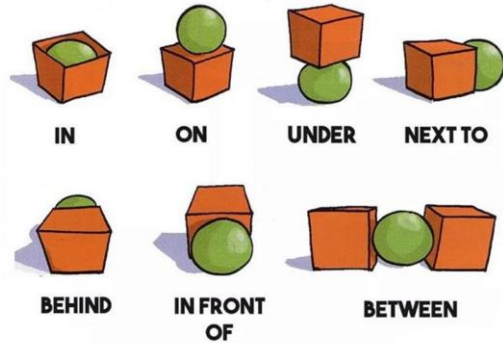

One-syllable adjectives 	long – longer straight – straighter big – bigger	tall – taller large – larger hot – hotter
Two-syllable adjectives 	honest – more honest happy – happier narrow – narrower	famous – more famous crazy – crazier gentle – gentler
Three or more syllables	expensive – more expensive popular – more popular confident – more confident	dangerous – more dangerous beautiful – more beautiful difficult – more difficult
Irregular adjectives 	good – better bad – worse far – farther	many – more little – less far – further
